**\*Essays should be typed and double-spaced.**

### Judging Criteria

Members of Northeastern Center Staff will judge the entries. Essays will be judged in three areas:

- ◆ Creativity/Originality
- ◆ Spelling/Grammar/Punctuation

### Entry Deadline

All entries must be postmarked by **May 3rd, 2010.**

From all entries received, one student will be chosen to receive the \$700.00 Jane George Scholarship. The winner will be notified by May 31st, 2010.
