- Provides no-wrong-door access to mental health and substance use care.
- Will offer walk-in, referral, and drop-off options.
- Individuals receiving care will be assessed for: medical stability, suicide risk, substance use crisis, & a violence risk assessment.
- These crisis stabilization services are designed to reduce, improve, and prevent a behavioral health crisis and/or reduce acute symptoms.
- Open 24 hours, 7 days a week



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
